

### A MESSAGE FROM FR. DIEHM

Dear pastorate family,

This is the last Sunday of Ordinary Time before Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on March 6<sup>th</sup>. Masses for Ash Wednesday will be 10 a.m. in Holy Cross (with La Salle Catholic School kids), 5:15 p.m. in Rickardsville (general Pastorate Mass), and 7:15 p.m. in Sherrill (with Faith Formation kids). It is a day of fasting and abstinence. The Pastorate Lent Calendar is included in this weekend's bulletin. In the meantime, though, it's still Ordinary Time. This weekend, the first reading and the Gospel remind us about how our speech reflects who we are, as Jesus teaches, "... from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks." This means that the kind of things we say reflect who we are. If we are inwardly virtuous, our words will reflect our virtuous heart. If we are inwardly vicious (i.e. full of vice, the opposite of virtue), our words will reflect our vicious heart. What do YOUR words say about the kind of person YOU are?

The goal is to bear good fruit by how we live our lives – Jesus teaches, "A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit. For every tree is known by its fruit." So, what kind of fruits are you seeing in your life? Does drama surround you? Are you a dramatic person? Does peace surround you? Are you a peaceful person? While trees can't change their nature, human beings can change theirs. It's called repentance – turning away from vice toward virtue, away from sin toward grace, and away from the creature toward the Creator. Is there something in your life that you need to repent of? Something you need to turn away from? Repentance is an act of personal reform – when we repent, we communicate to God that we want to be better, that we want to act better. And God helps us, but we have to live in relationship with Him. May we turn away from sin and toward God and so bear good fruit.

STO Applications: The Archdiocese of Dubuque uses the company FACTS to handle applications for tuition assistance online. The link to the application is found on the school website. You can use a smartphone to apply including taking photos of and submitting the supporting documentation needed. The application fee is \$31 per family (not per student). Families who apply for STO will receive a \$25 gift of scrip from the school to help offset the application fee. The deadline for applications is April 15, 2019.

La Salle Catholic School is working to build opportunities for local tuition assistance. As procedures are established for the granting of local assistance, the STO application through FACTS will be an important step. Even if you feel you wouldn't qualify for STO, to be considered for local assistance, you must complete the STO application. Please complete the STO application as soon as possible.

### Praying as a Catholic – How's YOUR prayer life?

We continue to go through the fourth part of the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) on prayer. What follows is the fourth and fifth paragraphs

from the Catechism on prayer – "2561) "You would have asked him, and he would have given you living water." Paradoxically our prayer of petition is a response to the plea of the living God: "They have forsaken me, the fountain of living waters, and hewn out cisterns for themselves, broken cisterns that can hold no water!" Prayer is the response of faith to the free promise of salvation and also a response of love to the thirst of the only Son of God. Prayer as covenant. 2562) Where does prayer come from? Whether prayer is expressed in words or gestures, it is the whole man who prays. But in naming the source of prayer, Scripture speaks sometimes of the soul or the spirit, but most often of the heart (more than a thousand times). According to Scripture, it is the heart that prays. If our heart is far from God, the words of prayer are in vain." This is a good connection to the readings this weekend. If it is our heart that prays (and that's what scripture says), then a good prayer will flow from a good heart, whereas a disordered prayer will flow from a disordered heart. If we want to have a full and vibrant and living prayer life with God, then we have to have good heart health. When's the last time you went to confession? What do you need to repent of in order to have a good heart before God? How does your heart need to change in order to have a deeper relationship with God through prayer? Answering these questions honestly will help us have an authentic spiritual life, and a better relationship with the One who made us. It's good to repeat the wisdom of St. Augustine - "You have made us for Yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in You!"




